New business

- **Condition of Road, Culverts, Ditches:**
 - **Ditch Cleaning on 259th Street:** Mike cut back trees to fence line.
 - Mohr would like to turn some of his ditches from a V shape into more a U shape to make ditch mowing easier. It would not affect the water drainage of the ditch, it has very steep sides. His ditch runs from 256th Street to Eros Road. Board agreed that this would not be an issue and they could possibly find fill from ditch clean out to help if needed.
- **Review of SDTAT Conference:** Herll, Aaker, Brown & Tripp in attendance. Spoke with LTAP about Redwood/Chestnut traffic issues. They said they would try to speak with City of Brandon engineer about issues of Brandon city traffic.

Unfinished Business-

- **Scraper for Grader:** We have not been able to find one large enough. Will table until spring meeting.
- **Update On Road Conditions:**
 - Owner of property just north of Swedona church would like to move his approach/culvert 20 feet over for a different drive location. Would not be near any neighbors so it is allowed since he is not adding an approach.
- **Redwood/Chestnut Maintenance:** Traffic still an issue on the road and increase in large construction vehicles causing more road damage. Haug spoke about the amount of large side dumps and concrete trucks on the road. Board will discuss adding load limits in spring meeting.
- **Water Truck:** Still working on finding a truck, will table until spring meeting.
- **Clean ditch on 478th Ave:** Ditch by Kelly Lyon's property is full of silt, needs ditch clean out. Sioux Sanitary gave a bid of \$1,500-2,500 but this would be a spring project.
