- Redwood Treatment: Tripp has received bid for dust control treatment on Chestnut & Redwood Blvd where new water tower for the City of Brandon is being built. Bid has been sent over to city manager Bryan Reed and is on the agenda for the April 4, 2022 City of Brandon meeting.
- Change of May meeting date: Aaker unable to attend meeting on May 4, 2022, asked if we could meet on May 3, 2022 instead. Brown made motion to approve change of meeting date, Metzger 2nd motion. Unanimous vote, Motion Carried.
