- Hemlock Road Status: Touch base with Jay M. Libel to change street status to city of Brandon: Will contact Jay Libel
- Narrowing 259th Street: Status of bid from contractor for mailbox removal, project updates:
 - o No longer needing place to remove excess dirt
 - o Mailboxes will be placed in temporary buckets and will be moved to approximate location
 - o Construction will be one mile at a time
 - o Mostly sure that will only have mild delays in traffic but road will remain open, unless contractor feels closing road would speed up the process
- Box culvert on 479th (South of Swedona Lutheran Church): Permit status update: No longer needed
- Plugged culvert at 47871 257th Street: Order is placed for new one, waiting on shipment
- Johnson Property Culvert Discussion (Hwy 11 & 260th Street): Still waiting on cleaning out of culverts
